**** New Attendance Policy ****

Caledonia High school will be implementing a new attendance policy, beginning at the start of the fall 2008 trimester. The policy in its entirety will be found in the new student handbook. The following is a brief overview of the main highlights of the new policy:

- ❖ A student receiving a combination of 8 excused/unexcused absences in a trimester class must achieve a C+ or better on the final exam/project to have their grade calculated for that class.
- ❖ A student who reaches 13 absences in a trimester class will automatically lose credit for that class.
- ❖ Absence-notification letters will be mailed home on 5th and 7th absences, requiring parents to contact high school administration to discuss absences.

Poor attendance is directly linked to poor academic success. Parents are highly encouraged to schedule appoints and vacations on non-school times to avoid jeopardizing their student's chances at being successful in the classroom.
